I pitched the idea of doing an 'Antiques Roadshow' style series which has been a great success, giving us the opportunity to travel to places like Burlington Vermont and the Spellman Museum in Massachusetts to highlight some rare items and unique collections. We've had over half a dozen roadshows so far and they've been a great way for me to hone my storytelling skills as well as learn new shooting and editing tricks.

As one of the Media Managers/DITs working on the 'North Woods Law NH' TV show, it was my job to offload, review, and log all the footage the film crew would shoot throughout the day. Release forms for each person and location the film crew came across while shooting would be organized by date, and once I had about a week's worth of footage, I'd send it down to Engel Entertainment in NYC for the editors and producers to turn into videos.

I'd often ride along too, getting to either drive the chase car or film from the passenger seat. I had been a big fan of NWL when they were filming in Maine for the first few seasons, so being able to work on a show I was so familiar with as a viewer was an incredible learning experience and a great peek behind the curtain.

I was the videographer and editor for a string of projects my friends and I did while attending college, one of them being my own film, "Light's Journey".
